Spirit of Construction Foundation Scholarship

Foundation Purpose

The principal purpose of the Foundation shall be to recognize, celebrate, and elevate the Construction Industry and its contributions to the civic, aesthetic, and economic well-being of the Greater Cincinnati Region. This purpose shall be pursued by activities including honoring eminent constructors and their achievements, and promoting civic and educational ventures which benefit construction.

Description

The purpose of the scholarship is to recognize individual student accomplishments, bring those students in contact with leaders of construction in the Greater Cincinnati Region, and sustain the Foundations goal of promoting education ventures that benefit construction. The Spirit of Construction has made available two \$1,500 scholarships for Northern Kentucky University students.

Requirements

1. Be a declared major in Construction Management.
2. Have completed coursework placing them beyond the sophomore year.
3. Have a minimum overall cumulative GPA of 3.0.
4. Submit an essay of no more than 1,500 words based on the following description:
“Among the factors to be considered in the evaluation of the scholarship application will be academic performance, service, financial need, leadership, etc. The essay should explain to the individual institution committee why you need the scholarship, for what purpose you intend to use the monetary award, why you feel you are a deserving candidate, and one paragraph summarizing what motivated you to select a career in the construction industry.”
5. Honorees of the Spirit of Construction Foundation Scholarship will be invited and expected to attend the annual Celebration of Construction event in October. Students will receive at least one complimentary ticket to the event (current ticket prices start at \$150).

Deadline

Application and essay must be received by the Department of Construction Management by April 1, 2009.
